Our worship services include a mix of hymns and worship songs both old and new with


the common characteristic of exalting our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.

of God's Word. Not only are sinners evangelized through the proclamation of Scripture, believers who are equipped through the Word of God are made into effective evangelists themselves.



Faith
