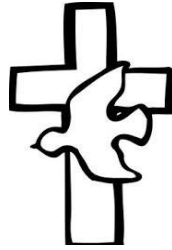


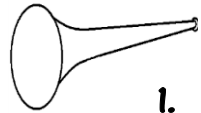
Benediction:

How to worship: Pray for God's Spirit to help you die to yourself and live for Christ. Then go and do so!



What is the Gospel?



1. God Rules. The Bible tells us God

created everything, including you and me, and He is in charge of everything. (Genesis 1:1, Revelation 4:11, Colossians 1:16-17)

2. We Sinned. We all choose to disobey God. The Bible calls this sin. Sin separates us from God and deserves God's punishment of death. (Romans 3:23, 6:23)

3. God Provided. God sent Jesus, the perfect solution to our sin problem, to rescue us from the punishment we deserve. It's something we, as sinners, could never earn on our own. Jesus alone saves us. (John 3:16, Ephesians 2:8-9)

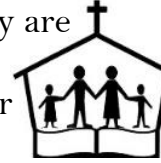
4. Jesus Gives. He lived a perfect life, died on the cross for our sins, and rose again. Since Jesus gave up His life for us, we can be welcomed into God's family for eternity. (Romans 5:8, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Peter 3:18, Ephesians 2:8-9)

5. We Respond. Believe in your heart that Jesus alone saves you through what He's already done on the cross. Repent, turning from self and sin to Jesus. Tell God and others that your faith is in Jesus. (John 14:6, Romans 10:9-10, 13)

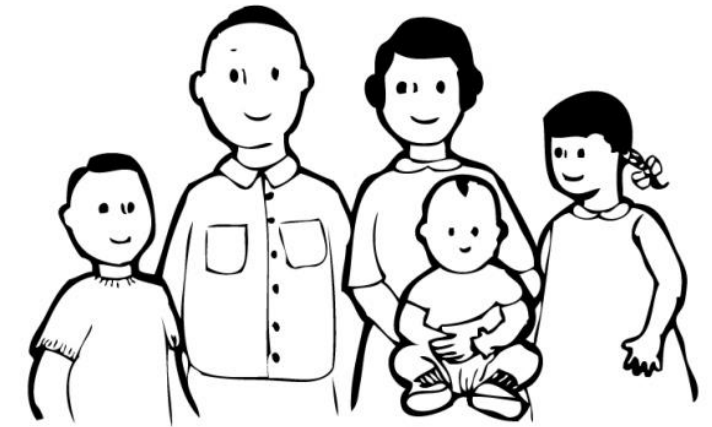

Order of Worship

Prelude: During this time, we prepare ourselves to worship our God.

How to worship: Read a passage from the Bible (maybe the ones listed by "Scripture Reading" or "Preaching"). Pray for God's help to worship Him as He should be worshiped.

Welcome: Romans 15:7 tells us to "welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God."

Pastor Steve will welcome and prepare us for worship by reading Scripture.



How to worship: Start greeting people when you arrive.



Singing: Psalm 100:1-2 commands us to "make a joyful noise to the Lord" and "come into His presence with singing!" Benita and the praise team will lead us in this.

Songs we will sing:

Before Scripture reading:

- "Come, Christians, Join to Sing"
- "For All the Saints"

After Scripture reading:

- "He Touched Me"
- "All I Have Is Christ"

After the Sermon:

- "Living for Jesus"

How to worship: Stand up, sing your best, and think about the words while singing.

Scripture Reading: Psalm 124

The apostle Paul commands us to "devote [ourselves] to the public reading of Scripture" (1 Timothy 4:13), which means that we read God's word out loud!

How to worship: You can either find the passage and read along, or just pay close attention while it is read.

Prayer: Prayer is coming to God and asking Him to do what we cannot do for ourselves. Jesus tells us what we should pray for in Matthew 6:9-13.



How to worship: Listen to the prayer and write parts of it in your own words. Go the extra mile and compare find what parts of the prayer match with Matthew 6:9-13!

Giving: Every Lord's Day (Sunday), we gather money offerings to fund our missionaries, take care of our pastors and staff, and keep the building clean and useful.



How to worship: Set aside money; give cheerfully, for God has cheerfully given to us; pray for a cheerful attitude if needed.
