- 1) **Baptism** Upon a public profession of their faith in Jesus Christ as their Savior and a commitment of their life to him as Lord, a person may be received as a candidate for baptism.
- 2) **Letter** A person may be received upon presentation of or promise of a letter of dismissal from another church; provided they have received Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord and have followed with baptism by immersion.
- 3) **Statement** A person may be received upon their statement of a prior conversion experience and baptism when no letter is obtainable.

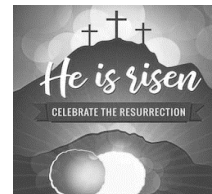

### Staying Physically and Spiritually Healthy During the National Health Crisis

*"Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul." 3 John 1:2*

#### Physical Health:

- Wash your hands frequently (soap and water or hand gel) and avoid touching your face.
- Use hygiene etiquette:
  - No handshakes, hugging or other similar gestures.
  - Cough and sneeze in to your elbow or tissue- throw tissue away.
  - Practice social distancing from others (6 feet).
  - Avoid crowds such as at public events, restaurants, and shopping areas (especially if you are over 60 and/or have a compromising health condition).
- Stay home if you are sick, especially if you have a fever and/or cough.

#### Spiritual Health:

- Attend church services if appropriate and you are able.
- If not able to attend, watch and actively participate in worship at home with Facebook livestream or the recorded version on the church website.
- Daily spend time in Bible study and prayer.
- Give your regular tithes and offerings to support the mission of our church.
- Connect with fellow believers via the phone or social media to share trials and triumphs. Pray together- praising and thanking God for his goodness and lifting up concerns and needs.
