- 1) **Baptism** Upon a public profession of their faith in Jesus Christ as their Savior and a commitment of their life to him as Lord, a person may be received as a candidate for baptism.
- 2) **Letter** A person may be received upon presentation of or promise of a letter of dismissal from another church; provided they have received Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord and have followed with baptism by immersion.
- 3) **Statement** A person may be received upon their statement of a prior conversion experience and baptism when no letter is obtainable.

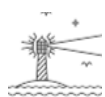

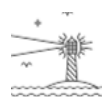

Staying Healthy at Church in Our New Normal

"Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul." 3 John 1:2

Please follow these guidelines:

- Practice physical distancing from others (at least 6 feet).
- Wear a cloth mask. Please do not sing without a mask on.
- No handshakes, hugging or other similar gestures.
- Wash your hands frequently (soap and water or hand gel) and avoid touching your face, especially after touching any surface.
- Use the restroom one person/household at a time.
- Consider staying home and watching on livestream if you are at higher risk for severe illness with a COVID-19 infection.
- Stay home if you have an elevated temperature (>100.5) or COVID -19 symptoms such as dry cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of smell/taste, stomach illness, etc.
