- 3) **Statement** A person may be received upon their statement of a prior conversion experience and baptism when no letter is obtainable.

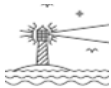

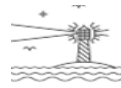

## Staying Healthy at Church in Our New Normal

Please follow these guidelines:
